#### **HOLY WEEK**

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** You are welcome to join us in church for the Stations of the Cross this Sunday afternoon at 3.00pm. There will be outdoor Stations of the Cross as an act of Christian witness around the Harrytown and Bredbury Green area on Good Friday following Morning Prayer in church at 9.30am.

**RECONCILIATION IN HOLY WEEK** There will be the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Monday during Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 7.00pm – 8.00pm. Quiet music will be played during this time to aid reflection and prayer.

**THE VENERATION OF THE CROSS ON GOOD FRIDAY** There will be the option to either simply touch the figure of Jesus with your hand or genuflect before it. Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence – please see below. The retiring collection at the Good Friday service will be for the support of Christians and the Christian shrines in the Holy Land.

**GOOD FRDIAY FASTING & ABSTINENCE** Those over the age of eighteen are bound by the law of fasting (reducing the amount of food) until the beginning of their sixtieth year, while all over the age of fourteen are bound by the law of abstinence (refraining from meat). The obligation arises in imitation of Christ himself and in response to his call. During his life on earth Our Lord undertook voluntary penance. He invited his followers to do the same. The penance he invited would be a participation in his own suffering, an expression of inner conversion and a form of reparation for sin. It would be a personal sacrifice made out of love for God and our neighbour. There are two days of fasting and abstinence in the Chruch's year: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday.
