MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL: Today, the second Sunday of Easter, is Divine Mercy Sunday which points us the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery — the whole mystery of the death, burial and resurrection of Christ — made present for us in the Eucharist. Divine Mercy is particularly associated with the Polish nun Sr Faustina Kowalska who received revelations from Our Lord in the 1930s and who was canonised by St John Paul II in the year 2000.

It was wonderful to see so many people attend the Holy Week Masses and services this year and I hope it will lead to a renewal and strengthening of faith as we strive to live the Easter message of peace, joy and hope knowing that the presence and power of the Risen Lord are with us.
