MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL: Today we celebrate the solemn feast of Pentecost which brings to a close the Easter season. At Pentecost we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church and the beginning of her mission in the world. As the people of God, we have received the gifts of the Holy Spirit to strengthen us in faith so that we can witness to the Christ in word and deed. So, on this day of special prayer let us pray for ourselves that we may grow in faith and joyfully share it with others.

Ordinary time resumes again tomorrow (Monday) and the liturgical colour changes from white to green. Ordinary time is the longest period in the whole liturgical year and ends this year on Saturday 30th November. A new liturgical year will then begin with the first Sunday of Advent.


