CHURCH ORGAN UPDATE I am pleased to say that an organ has been purchased to replace the previous instrument, which served our parish faithfully for 35 years. Due to failing intermittently and the increasing difficulty in sourcing replacement parts, it was no longer viable to maintain.

Following approval from the Diocesan Finance Office and the parish finance committee, a **Makin Thirlmere 2-30 Tabstop Organ** has been acquired at a cost of £17,500. This high-quality ex-demo model includes additional speakers to enhance sound throughout the church, and comes with a 10-year guarantee. I am sure it will help to enhance the music and singing in church......here's to the next 35 years!

SACRED HEART PARISH WHALEY BRIDGE Fr Michael has had responsibility for the pastoral care of Sacred Heart Parish since September 2023. This will now come to an end with the appointment of a new priest, who will be entrusted with the care of both Sacred Heart and St Paul's, Poynton, from September.


PARISH FINANCE Last Sunday's collection: £718.40; CAFOD: £40.00. Thank you for your generous support of the parish.
