MARY'S MEALS You may recall that during the summer there was a collection of foreign and obsolete UK currency to support the work of Mary's Meals. The coins & notes came from more than 40 different countries! The total value came to an incredible £586.40, which is enough to provide at least 30 children (the equivalent of a whole class here in UK) with a daily meal in school for a full year or at 10p per serving, that's enough to provide 5864 nutritious portions of Mary's Meals. Thank you for supporting the currency collection in church.
