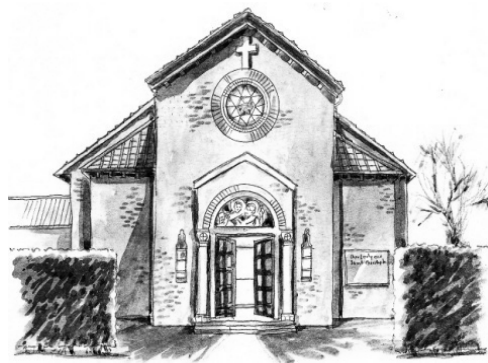

MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL Christmas has passed for another year, and we now return to Ordinary Time, marked by the liturgical colour green. Although it lacks the distinctiveness of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, special seasons in the Church's year, Ordinary Time is still a season of steady growth in faith.

The green banners displayed in the church sanctuary carry particular meaning. The letters *ICXC* form a four-letter abbreviation of the name of Jesus Christ in Greek, known as a Christogram. The banner depicting the loaves and fishes reminds us of the central place of the Eucharist in our lives.
